According to preliminary data, in the first half of 2021, net exports of agricultural products from the country amounted to 636.4 million euros, which is 31.8% more than in the same period of 2020. The leading commodity groups in the structure of agricultural exports are **cereals and oilseeds**. They are followed by **vegetable fats, food waste and prepared animal feed, soft and alcoholic beverages, cereal-based foods.** There is an attempt to increase the export of **Bulgarian wine** to China and Japan.
